With above-average numbers of non-nationals in Spain, Portugal, and Ireland, the project aims to respond to growing needs for integration through education and community-building.

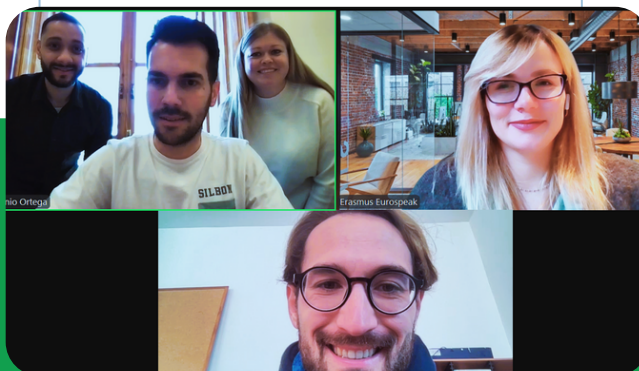
